

NAD ACF Student Representative Guidelines



Conference Student Representation

- A. ACF chapter officers serve on Conference ACF Advisories
- B. Conference Youth/Young Adult Director or ACF/PCM Coordinator designate an ACF Student as a conference representative to the Union PCM Advisory
- C. All Conference student representatives from each conference throughout a union serve on the Union PCM Advisory

Union Representatives are:

- A. Members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church in regular standing
- B. Active members of an ACF Chapter within the Union territory they represent
- C. Appointed by the Union Youth Director or Union Public Campus Ministry Representative.
- D. Present at duly called meetings (in person or virtually)

The functions of the Union Representatives are:

- A. be the representative voice of the ACF chapters throughout their union or conferences.
- B. be the representative voice of ACF students when gathered together.
- C. be the representative voice from the conference or union back to the local chapter.

NAD Representation opportunities are:

- A. Serve on the NAD PCM Committee and Advisory
- B. Serve on the NAD ACF Institute Planning Team
- C. Represent ACF students on the NAD University Student Leaders Advisory
- D. Represent ACF students at the NAD Education Convention 2028
- E. Represent ACF students at NAD events when invited by the NAD PCM Director and approved by the Union PCM Director or Rep
